Waterside Estate Water Quality Monitoring

(Len Robinson Strata Management on behalf of the Waterside Estate Community Association) ongoing monitoring and management of the water bodies and riparian vegetation within the Waterside Estate at Castlereagh Road Penrith.

One Tree Reach Wetland Plan of Management (PoM) (Hornsby Shire Council) preparation of a PoM for a natural wetland adjacent to the Hawkesbury River. Issues included the presence of acid sulfate soils, endangered ecological communities and threatened species and the potential invasion of saltmarsh by mangroves. The PoM included a community and stakeholder consultation program and consideration of the impacts of predicted sea level rise as a result of climate change.

Management Plan (Warringah Council) preparation of a detailed management plan documenting the site setting and context, biodiversity and habitat values, preparation of detailed weed density maps, along with a management issues analysis with management strategies, actions and performance targets for a variety of management zones.

Kareela Golf Course Management Plan

(Sutherland Council) (in prep) identify ecological social and recreational values of the golf course, develop management strategies to protect these values and assist Council and Golf Course Officials to make informed decisions to protect these values.

Galston Gorge Vegetation Management Plan

(Ausgrid) detailed mapping, implementation plan for management strategies and actions to mitigate impacts of track upgrades and easement maintenance on vegetation communities within Berowra Valley Regional Park.
